1. **2020 Ride Season Update:** The Region 6 Board of Directors met last Wednesday, July 8th. During this meeting, the board discussed the 2020 Region 6 ride schedule and concerns regarding the recent increases in coronavirus cases as well as the recent outbreaks of Vesicular Stomatitis Virus (VSV), especially as of late in Kansas.

Following their discussions, the board voted unanimously to cancel all A and B rides for Open, CP, and Novice for the 2020 ride season. The board also voted that Clinic and LeD rides could continue with management discretion for the 2020 ride season. Limited numbers were encouraged.

The Region 6 board also agreed that this message should be sent after the July 11-12 Clinic and LeD ride held at Branched Oak, NE.

The safety and well-being of our NATRC family is of utmost importance.

The LeD rides that were planned to be held with the El Dorado, Jesse James Rideout, and Exploring Sand Hills rides will NOT be held according to the ride management of those rides.

The Salt Creek Clinic and LeD ride has also been cancelled due to concerns with coronavirus and VSV in Kansas.

Indian Cave was changed to an LeD ride a few weeks ago. I am not aware of any other changes as of this evening. However, the sponsor of this ride, NECTRA will be having a meeting Monday July 13th and I am sure they will be discussing this ride. If anything were to change, I'm sure they will get the word out as soon as possible.

- 2. It has been and continues to be a challenging year for all of us. Our board discussed the possibilities of some scheduled weekends of just riding and camping with our Region 6 NATRC family. No judges, no check-ins, no P&Rs, just some good old fashioned trail riding and some social distancing sitting around a campfire. If you are interested and willing to manage a ride that would be very appreciated by all our members! We have locations in MO, KS, NE, and IA identified as possible ride locations. We just need ride managers to make it a reality. We have experienced ride managers very willing to serve as mentors for new ride managers.
