## Region 6 Membership Update November 11, 2022

- 2. During the upcoming 2023 ride season, the heavyweight and lightweight classes will be combined into an Adult class. This will be on a temporary basis for the 2023 ride year and will revert to 2022 rules unless extended by the National Board of Directors next summer. This will allow for larger classes and increases the opportunity for our horses and riders to earn more points towards regional and national awards. (There will still be sweepstakes winners.)
- 3. Beginning with the 2023 ride season, 8-year-old riders will be eligible to compete. They must be able to care for their horse with minimal assistance. Riders 12 and under must ride with an adult sponsor or a junior sponsor, 13 or older with more than 250 NATRC miles, with a limit of two per sponsor. The sponsor must also be a registered participant in an appropriate division.
- 4. It is time to renew your NATRC membership! Renew by the deadlines below and you will be entered to win some fantastic prizes! One name will be drawn from those who have renewed by each cut off date. If your name is not drawn, it will remain in the pot for the remaining dates. - 7. Our Region 6 convention will be held the weekend of March 24-26, 2023, at the Embassy Suites by Hilton in Omaha, NE. Our convention hotel is in the Old Market area, which is Omaha's most historic, most entertaining neighborhood. We will be recognizing the achievements of our members during this exciting weekend. We are looking for volunteers to help put together our convention workshops. If you would be willing to help with our convention program planning, please let me know.
- 8. Sacramento is calling! Make like a Pony Express rider and plan now to attend the national NATRC convention February 17-19 in Sacramento, CA hosted by Region 1. (Please note the updated convention date!) Besides the outstanding convention programming that is being planned, you can check out the city's history that is readily on display at places like Old Sacramento, near the waterfront. This historic district dates back to the mid-1800's and the California Gold Rush. Stay tuned for more convention and registration information soon.
