

BRUSHY CREEK

Competitive Trail Ride August 17-18, 2024

Brushy Creek State Recreation Area, 3134 290th St, Lehigh, IA 50557

Governed and Sanctioned by the Rules of the North American Trail Ride Conference (NATRC)

Brushy Creek is one of Iowa's premier outdoor recreation destinations. At 6,500 acres, it has a mosaic of native prairie, grassland, timber, riparian and lake habitats. The 690-acre lake is the deepest artificial permanent pool lake in Iowa and has an extensive network of all-weather horse trails.

The south equestrian campground has a modern shower and restroom, electric and non-electric sites along with some full hookup sites (water and sewer), a playground, horse wash area, ample shade, and a hitch rail at every site.

Directions: From Highway 20, head south on Union Ave for 4.5 miles, then turn East onto 290th Street and continue for 1.3 miles, the campground will be on your right.

Ride Details: Late arrivals should make arrangements with ride management

A ride limit: 60 per day

A and B1 Ride: Check in 2pm until 6pm on Friday with ride secretary, ride briefing 6pm

B2 Ride: Check in 2pm until 6pm on Saturday with ride secretary, ride briefing 6pm

Leisure ride limit: 20 per day

B1 LeD Saturday: Check in 9-10am on Saturday, ride briefing at 11am, time out at noon

B2 LeD Sunday: Check in 8-8:15 on Sunday, ride briefing at 8:30am, time out at 9am

Dogs are not allowed in management area, check in, briefings, or meals and must be leashed at all times per insurance requirements.

Camping: We will be using the South Equestrian Campground. The park advised to get reservations as soon as possible as it can be quick to fill up. There are a good number of reservable and non-reservable sites. Reservations open 3 months in advance, so should be able to book by May 18th, 2024. Stabling: All horses must be tied to hitching post per park rules!

Current negative Coggins required on all horses.

Current health papers within 30 days of the event required on all out of state horses.
