Clinic (Saturday Oct 12) **Leisure Division Ride** (Saturday & Sunday Oct 12 & 13) **25 Rider Daily Limit**

Clinic participants will check-in with the Ride Secretary on Sat Oct 12 beginning at 7:30am. Clinic presentations will start at 8:30am and conclude at 11 am. This will allow all clinic participants to compete in the afternoon Leisure Division (LeD) ride.

A Leisure Division (LeD) Ride will be offered both Saturday afternoon and Sunday mornings. The LeD ride will start with check-in of horses starting at 12:30 pm on Saturday and 9:00 am on Sunday. Riders will time-out at 1:30 pm on Saturday and 10:00 am on Sunday. The distance will be 8 - 12 miles at a pace of approximately 3.5 mph. There will be one P&R (Pulse and Respiration check) and 4 to 5 judging observations. This ride is sanctioned by the North American Trail Ride Conference (NATRC) and NATRC members will earn points towards regional year-end awards and mileage. (First time members are eligible for a free competing NATRC membership.) Teams will be scored and placed first through sixth.

Directions: Oak Ridge Equestrian Campground is located on the eastern side of Whiterock Conservancy. From the West on IA-141 drive through Coon Rapids and turn right (south) on N56/Fig Ave. Coming from the East on IA-141, drive through Bayard (small town) and turn left (south) on N56/Fig Ave. (There will be a large white Whiterock Conservancy sign at this intersection). Drive ~1.4 miles to 125th street on the left hand side of the road and turn left (east). The campground is the first right on the south side of 125th street.

Ride Notes: A current negative Coggins Certificate and a current Health Certificate (within 30 days of this event) is required on all out-of-state horses. No current negative Coggins or a current Health Certificate is required for Iowa horses. **Dogs** are not allowed in management area, check-in and briefings areas and **must be leashed** at all times (insurance requirement).

Camping: There are 13 electrical camping spots at the Oak Ridge Campground (site of the ride headquarters). Primitive camping is available in the Oak Ridge Campground and the nearby River Campground. A limited number of pens and tie-lines are available. Also, horses can be stationary-tied to trailer for overnight primitive camping in the designated area. Contact Megan Capek to reserve your camping site and/or pen @ 712-790-8221 ext 1. There is a modern restroom in the Oak Ridge Campground and porta-potties at the River Campground. There will be day use parking available for non-campers.

Food: Bring your own food for yourself and your horse. On Saturday evening there will be a group potluck dinner and a campfire afterwards, please bring a dish to share!

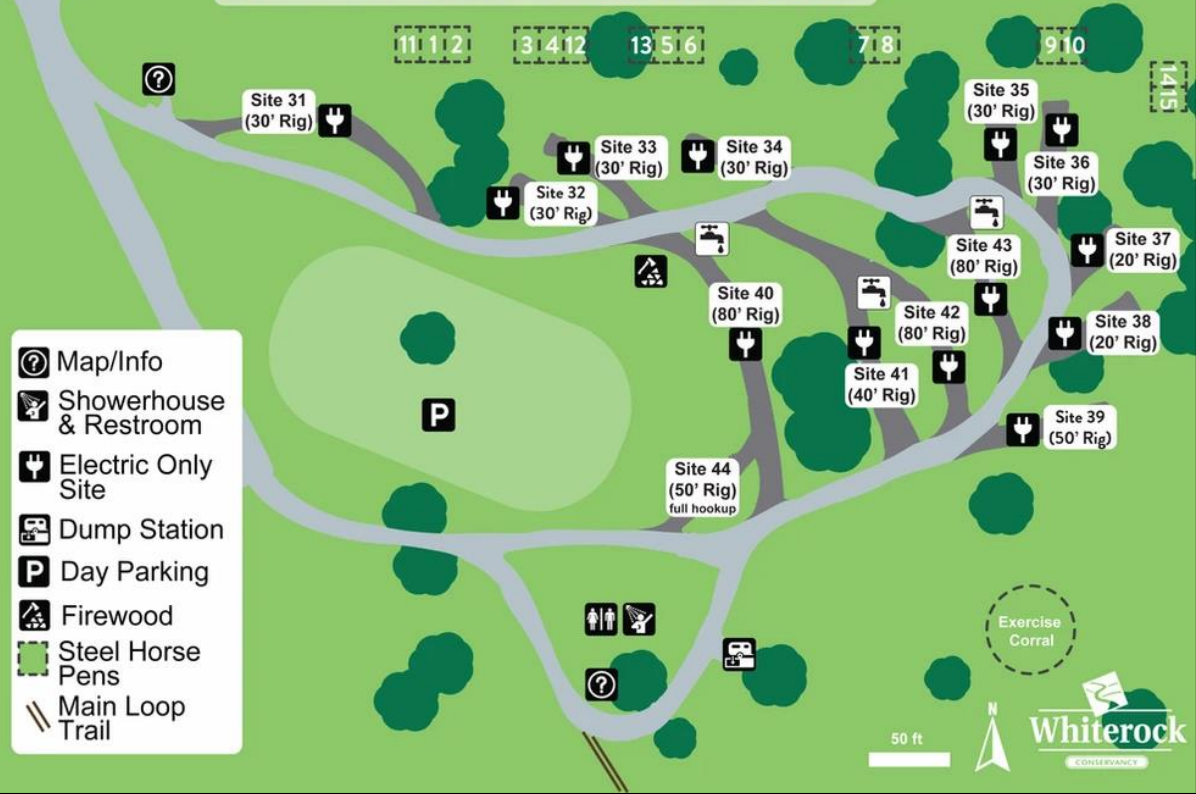
