Directions: Oak Ridge Equestrian Campground is located on the eastern side of Whiterock Conservancy. From the West on IA-141 drive through Coon Rapids and turn right (south) on N56/Fig Ave. Coming from the East on IA-141, drive through Bayard (small town) and turn left (south) on N56/Fig Ave. (There will be a large white Whiterock Conservancy sign at this intersection). Drive ~1.4 miles to 125th street on the left hand side of the road and turn left (east). The campground is the first right on the south side of 125th street.

Trails: Our trails will take you through savannas, rolling pastures, native and restored prairies, wetlands, riverside bluffs, and beside fishing ponds. Shoes are suggested but not required.

Ride Notes: A current negative Coggins Certificate is required on all horses. A current Health Certificate (within 30 days of this event) is required on all out-of-state horses. **Dogs** are not allowed in management area, check-in and briefings areas and **must be leashed** at all times (insurance requirement).

Ride Details: Late arrivals should make arrangements with ride management.

A Ride: Check-in 2pm until dark on Friday - ride briefing planned for 6pm Friday and Saturday

B1 Ride Saturday: Check-in 2pm until dark on Friday - ride briefing planned for 6pm Friday

B1 LeD Saturday: Check-in riders at gam, followed by ride briefing

B2 LeD Sunday: Check-in riders at gam, followed by ride briefing

Camping & Stabling: There are 13 electrical camping spots (\$20 per night) at the Oak Ridge Campground (site of the ride headquarters). Primitive camping (\$15 per night) is available in the Oak Ridge Campground. A limited number of pens (\$8 per night) and tie-lines are available. Also, horses can be stationary-tied to trailer for overnight primitive camping in the designated area. There is a modern restroom in the Oak Ridge Campground. There will be day use parking available for non-campers. **Contact Laura Larson to reserve and pay for your camping site and/or pen @ 712-790-8221 ext 1.**
