NATRC Type B Ride (one day) - Leisure Division (B1 Saturday and/or B2 Sunday) 20 Rider Daily Limit

Directions: *From Cabool, MO*, go south on Hwy 181 for 22 miles to Hwy AA, turn right and go 2.5 miles to North Fork River Ranch. Watch for pipe fence on right as road curves to the left. Ranch gate is on the right and in the driveway, take the left fork to the campsites. *From Willow Springs & West Plains*, at the 60-63 junction west take second Willow Springs exit, turn left onto 76 E, turn left on 181 S to Hwy AA turn right 2.5 miles to Ranch.

Trail: Combination of forest trails, logging trails and gravel roads. The trail substrate is rock, gravel, and pasture. Shoes or boots are recommended. Some terrain will be steep and rocky.

Camping: Electric/water hookups or bunk rooms are \$35. Cabins are available but not close to stalls. Sites have been reserved but contact NFRR directly to book. [<https://www.nfrranch.info/services>] There is a very nice shower house and eating room with picnic tables where ride briefings will be held. Contact Darrin if you have questions: 417-257-4953.

Stabling: Everyone will have a covered stall; stall fee is \$7/night. Stalls are required. Designated manure dumping areas.

Ride Notes: A current negative Coggins Certificate is required on all horses. A current Health Certificate (within 30 days of this event) is required on all out-of-state horses. **Dogs** are not allowed in the management area, check-in area, or briefings, and **must be leashed at all times** per our event insurance policy and campground rules.

Ride Details: The ride will start with rider check-in with the ride secretary at 8:30 am; followed by ride briefing and check-in of horses. Time-out will start at approximately 10:00 am. The distance will be 8 to 12 miles at a pace of approximately 3.5 mph.

Meals: Potluck dinner Saturday night, management will provide the meat. Bring your own tableware and drinks. Workers will be fed breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday and breakfast and lunch on Sunday.
